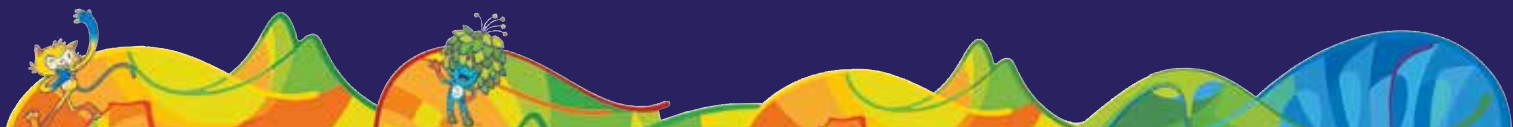

CISM Rio Club 2016

For the first time in its history, in the framework of the 2016 Rio Olympic Games, the CISM decided to create the 2016 Rio CISM Club. Thanks to the Brazilian delegation in CISM and its Chief of Delegation Vice Admiral Paulo Martino Zuccaro, a dedicated place was established for all the members of the CISM Family who were present in Rio. With this initiative, CISM wanted to provide to its participants and member nations' delegates some administrative and protocol support for their activities during Rio 2016 Olympic Games. From 4th to 21st August 2016, the Rio 2016 CISM Club was located at the UNIFA (Brazilian Air Forces University), established in 1983 with the mission of improving and strengthening the official knowledge of

Air Force's superior and general officers. Other important military organizations of the Air Force are based on the university campus, including the Training Center Specialized Aeronautics (CIEAR), the Aerospace Museum (MUSAL) and the Institute of Aerospace Medicine (IMAE). Delegates from Brazil, Sri Lanka and Qatar participated to the 2016 Rio CISM Club and could enjoy the services implemented for them.

This special issue will cover several important events scheduled during the 2016 CISM Rio Club: an Opening and a Closing Ceremony, a Press conference in presence of several local and international media delegates during which the CISM delegation had the opportunity to introduce CISM



activities and goals, a cultural visit, and goals, a cultural visit, the visit of the CSKA Russian House and of the House of Switzerland as well as the important signings of two Memorandum of Understanding with the FEI (Federation Equestre Internationale) and FIVB (Federation Internationale de Volleyball) which are expressing a convergence of will between the parties, indicating an intended common line of action. Those MoU's are expressing a convergence of will between the parties, indicating an intended common line of action as well as the visit of the CSKA Russian House and of the House of Switzerland.

Apart from those highlights, this special issue will also focus on the fact that more than 20% of the Olympic Games participants' were military athletes. Indeed, this year in Rio de Janeiro, the CISM athletes managed to win 114 Olympic Medals (33 gold medals, 38 silver medals and 43 bronze medals). This impressive figure shows the importance and the strength of the military sport around the world and encourages the CISM to further develop its activities! Moreover, we have to emphasize the historical contribution of the Brazilian Armed Forces during those Olympic Games who helped to the organization of 10 Olympic Sports!

The CISM Rio Club 2016 Events & Protocol

As usual, three important events related to protocol took place in the CISM Rio Club: the Opening and Closing Ceremony as well as a Press Conference with several media representatives.


The Opening Ceremony was held in the UNIFA (Brazilian Air Force University) auditorium ECEMAR on 7th of August with the exceptional presence of Mr. Raul Jungmann, the Minister of Defence and the Chiefs of Staff of all branches of the Brazilian Armed Forces. A large crowd of media and spectators attended this event. This Opening Ceremony and the CISM Club Rio 2016 offered the possibility to the CISM President, Colonel AbdulHakeem AlShino, CISM Secretary General, Colonel Dorah Mamby Koita and CISM Chief Executive Officer, Mr. Olivier Verhelle, to showcase the excellence of all military athletes to the international Press. The Press Conference was indeed a great success with the presence of more than 60 journalists and 19 TV Channels, among others Globo TV, the main broadcaster of those Olympic Games. During this Press Conference, the Brazilian Minister of Defense Raul Jungmann and the

CISM President Colonel AbdulHakeem AlShino presented an overview of CISM and of the roles of the institutions in supporting the military athletes.

"Sport anticipates what is sometimes denied in relationships in the world, which is mutual respect and sharing. But we hope that the dream of a better world becomes a reality", declared Minister Raul Jungmann while CISM President Colonel AbdulHakeem AlShino said: *"But sport is not just Olympic content, it's also about fair play and using sport as a tool to promote peace around the world!"*. CISM President also stressed the fact that Brazil's first medal in Rio 2016 Olympic Games was won by Felipe Wu, a sergeant of the Brazilian Army, who participates in the High Performance Program of the Armed Forces.

After this successful Press Conference, a solemn ceremony was organized in the Air Command and Staff School College's auditorium and was attended by the following authorities: the Brazilian Minister of Defence Raul Jungmann, the CISM President, Colonel AbdulHakeem Alshino, CISM Secretary General, Colonel AbdulHakeem AlShino, Commanders of





Brazilian Armed Forces (Navy, Army and Air Force), Mrs. Jeniffer Mann, an IOC representative, Professor Lamartine da Costa, a very famous expert in sport in Brazil as well as numerous sports manager and top athletes. During this ceremony, the CISM President addressed words of gratitude to the Brazilian authorities for their continuous support to all CISM activities. The CISM Chancellery also awarded several Brazilian military and sports authorities with the CISM Order of Merit. At the same time, the Minister of Defense Raul Jungmann awarded the CISM President, Colonel Abdulhakeem Alshino, the CISM Secretary General, Colonel Dorah Mamby Koita and the CISM CEO, Mr. Olivier Verhelle, with the Brazilian Order of Military Sport Merit for their contribution to the development of sport within the Armed Forces. The ceremony was also the opportunity for CISM to deliver a presentation about CISM's contribution to the Olympic Ideals and Values. During this presentation, which had a real impact on the IOC Representative in attendance, Mrs. Jennyfer Mann, Head of Sport Partnerships & Coordination, Mr. Olivier Verhelle, the CISM CEO, addressed the following topics: the CISM Foundation, the Mission and

Vision, the Structure, the Sport Activities, Sport and Peace within CISM, Solidarity, CISM relevance and contribution to the Olympic Ideals, CISM Positioning on International sports arena.

On August 20, the Rio 2016 CISM Club ended up with the Closing Ceremony which took place in the Brazilian Navy Fortress of São José located in the center of Rio de Janeiro in presence of several Olympic Medalists from the Brazilian Armed Forces. During this event, the CISM President highlighted the importance of sport as an element that promotes unity and has the ability to integrate nations across the world.

"We are extremely grateful for the partnership with the Brazilian military sport and the recognition that we achieved at the Olympics", declared Colonel AbdulHakeem AlShino. Finally, the Chief of the Brazilian Delegation to CISM, the Vice Admiral Paulo Martino Zuccaro, took the floor to celebrate the impressive results obtained by military athletes at those 2016 Rio Olympics.



CISM signs Memorandum of Understanding with FEI

In the framework of the Rio 2016 CISM Club, CISM took the opportunity to develop the cooperation with some International Federations present in Rio. Indeed, CISM has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI), world governing body for equestrian sport. The MOU was signed by CISM President, Colonel AbdulHakeem AlShino (BRN) and FEI President Ingmar de Vos at the Olympic Equestrian Centre in Deodoro, Rio de Janeiro (BRA).



This partnership agreement will see the two organizations continue to work closely together to support the development of equestrian sport internationally.

In 2012, the FEI decided to use Memorandums of Understanding (MOUs) to better define its relationship with the different stakeholders. The MOUs cover universal issues such as FEI recognition, FEI Rules and Regulations, horse welfare, code of ethics, commitment to democratic processes, consultation, FEI General Assembly, FEI Sports Forum and meetings, governing law, dispute resolution, communication, and implementation.

Since years, Equestrian is a very important sport in the CISM Sports Program. CISM equestrian events include four disciplines: Jumping, Eventing, Dressage and Endurance. The last Military World Endurance Championship (2nd edition) took place in 2014 at the Dubai Equestrian Club (UAE), attracting a field of more than 70 participants.

"We are very pleased to formalize this partnership between the FEI and CISM", FEI President Ingmar De Vos said. "Equestrian is a key component of multi-sport events worldwide and the FEI is committed to developing these relationships to continually improve and increase the offering of equestrian sport across the globe. It was very fitting to sign the agreement at the Olympic Equestrian Centre in Deodoro, Rio, which is home to Brazil's largest military barracks, catering for more than 60,000 servicemen and women. We are looking forward to working with CISM over the coming years."



"Equestrian is an important sport of the CISM sports programme and, with the signing of this MOU, we are looking forward to developing our relationship with the FEI over the next years and working together to further raise the standard of equestrian in the military sports' world", CISM President Colonel AbdulHakeem Alshino said. "This agreement is a wonderful opportunity to exchange experiences and expertise between our two organizations."



CISM signs Memorandum of Understanding with FIVB

On August 10 in Rio de Janeiro (BRA), CISM signed another Memorandum of Understanding with the FIVB (Fédération Internationale de Volley-Ball) facilitating a four-year collaboration between the two organizations with the overall objective to promote volleyball within militaries around the world. The CISM delegation led by the CISM President Colonel AbdulHakeem AlShino and Secretary General Colonel Dorah Mamby Koita was welcomed by the FIVB President Dr. Ary S. Graça for the Signing Ceremony which took place at the FIVB Volleyball House just in front of the iconic Copacabana Beach.

This MoU, which will last until December 2020, highlights volleyball's position as a universal sport that can be played by everyone, at every time, everywhere and aims at harmonizing the technical cooperation between CISM, the CISM Member Nations and the FIVB to promote the development and sustainability of Volleyball and Beach Volleyball in the Military sports world .

The main aims of this MoU are the following:

- The promotion of volleyball sports practice amid all military sportsmen either professional or amateurs;
- The development of volleyball sports practice by military women;
- The establishment of true complementarities in the sports field between both institutions;
- The search for harmony between the strategies driven by the CISM Leaders and those by FIVB Leaders;
- The establishment of educative actions to preserve sports against the dangers of doping and violence;
- The qualification of coaches and referees through the courses organized by the FIVB and National Federations.



The FIVB President Dr. Ary S. Graça said: *"It is a huge honor to sign this MoU with a fantastic organization that I feel very passionately about. The CISM is committed to fostering world peace and volleyball truly is the sport of peace, uniting all ages, genders, nationalities and ethnicities and I am looking forward to four years of exciting collaboration."*

"It's another big day for us. Volleyball is one of the key team sports of our Sports Program and we really need to develop our relationship with FIVB over the next 4 years", declared CISM President, Colonel AbdulHakeem AlShino. *"This agreement will for sure help us to develop volleyball in the military sports' world"*



CISM visit the CSKA Russian House

As it is common during the Olympic Games, each country is organizing a “National House” during the games period to welcome athletes, fans, federations, clubs... As Russia is one of the CISM nations that counted the largest number of military athletes in Rio, the CSKA, the Military sports club of the Russian Armed Forces, took the initiative to set-up an Hospitality lounge at Fort Copacabana. On this occasion, the CISM President, Colonel Abdulkhakeem Alshino, and CISM Secretary General, Colonel Dorah Mamby Koita, were invited for an official visit of the temporary exhibition on military sports legends created by CSKA for the 2016 Rio OG. The CISM delegation received a warm welcome from Mrs. Svetlana Khorkina, a former multiple Olympic Champion, who was the ambassador of Russian military sports excellence.



This visit was also a way for CISM to prepare the 3rd CISM World Winter Games 2017, which will take place from February 22 to February 28 in Sochi (RUS). The Games were of course at the center of all conversations and the CISM Games Flame promotional run across Russia was also largely discussed. As an ambassador of Russian military sports excellence, Mrs. Svetlana Khorkina expressed to the CISM President the strong expectations of all the Russian Athletes regarding the organization of those Military Games to the Olympic standards and even above. “The CISM Games convey a message that goes even further than the Olympic ideals of peace”, declared Khorkina.

In Sochi, a Black sea-resort town who hosted the 2014 Winter Olympic, the CISM sports program will consist of 8 sports: biathlon, cross-country, alpine skiing, ski orienteering, ski mountaineering, patrol race, indoor sport climbing and short track speed skating.



In recent years, US\$12 billion have been invested in the development of Sochi mountain area and that of the surrounding infrastructure in preparation for the 2014 Olympic Winter Games. The Sochi mountain cluster is located at Krasnaya Polyana and is divided in two parts: the lower part lies at 560 meters and the upper part at 960 meters.

Krasnaya Polyana lies at the foot of the Caucasus Mountains and Gornaya Karousel lift-served summit rises to 2,320 meters, giving a vertical drop of 1,760 meters. The resort offers 30km of world-class ski slopes with an extensive range of slopes (from green to black) and 12 lifts for a total length of 10km will carry skiers to the slopes.

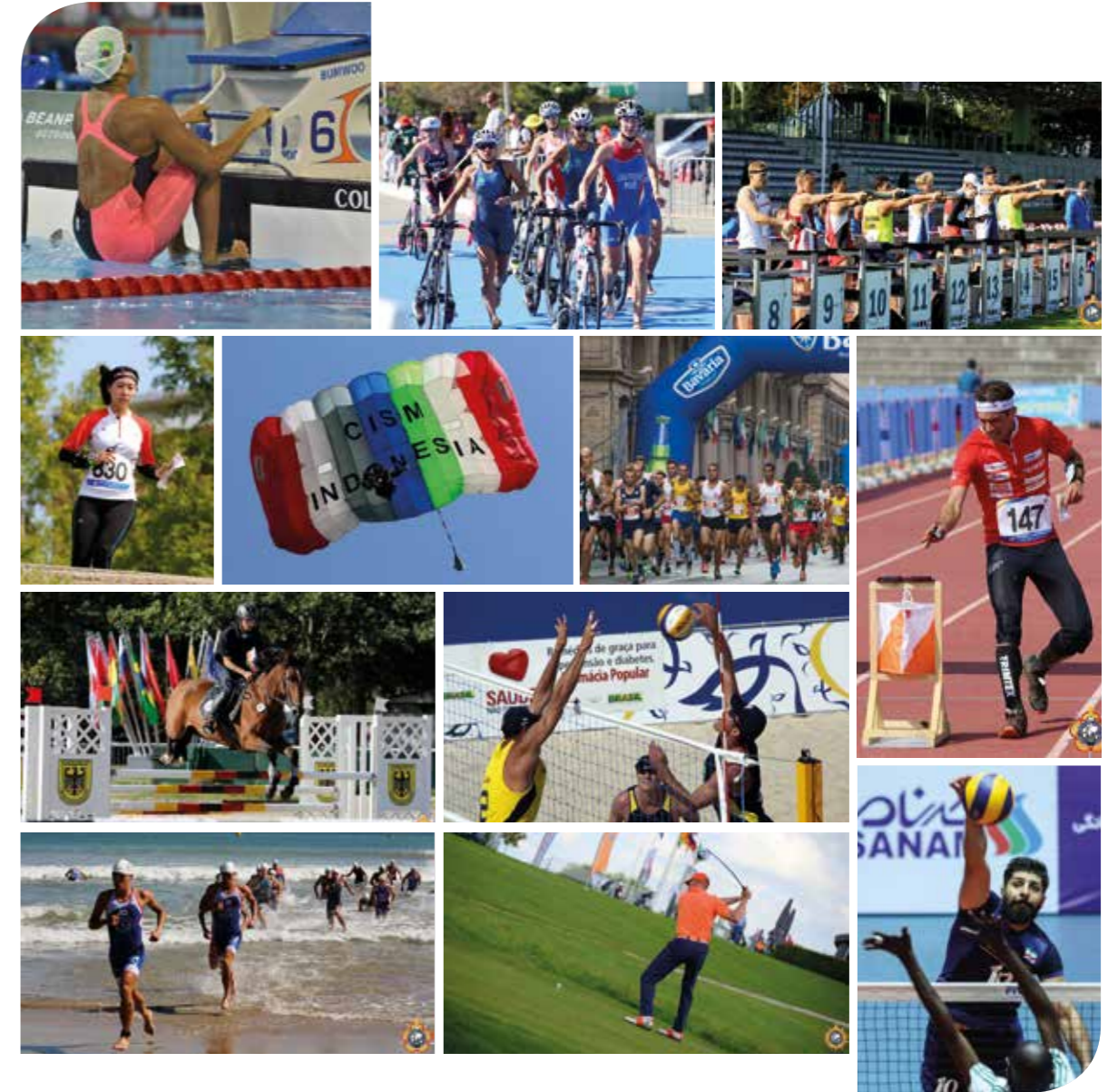
